COUNCILMAN'S BILL NO. 150 INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMAN

## A BILL

FOR AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF THE PARK NOW KNOWN AS THE NORTH SIDE PLAYGROUND, LOCATED ON WEST 38TH AND WEST 39TH AVENUES, BETWEEN NAVAJO AND OSAGE STREETS, TO COLUMBUS PARK.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

SECTION 1: That the name of the Park now known as the North Side Playground located on West 38th and West 39th Avenues, between Navajo and Osage Streets, be changed to Columbus Park.

SECTION 2: In the opinion of the Council this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public health, safety, convenience and general welfare, and it is enacted for that purpose and shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and final publication.
